

The qualified JP is available to witness documents such as Wills, Power of Attorney, affidavits, land transfer documents and other legal documents.

This close association also means that either the Library or Maleny Neighbourhood Centre can redirect enquiries.

Mary Valley Challenge

Sunday March 31st marked the first trial game for the new Hinterland tennis competition entitled the Mary Valley Challenge.

This social tennis competition consists of teams of three ladies and three men from the smaller hinterland clubs across a number of facility criteria. This criteria included, but was not restricted by, having four or less tennis courts and approximately 80 registered players.

The tennis clubs contacted included: Gherulla, Kandanga, Witta, Landsborough, Glenview, Mapleton, Kin Kin, Pomona, Gympie Queens Park, Wombye and Maleny. However, due to the short turnaround of nominations only three teams were prepared to play for the first match on Sunday.

the day comfortably being completed over four hours between 10.00 and 2.00 with time for a social lunch as well. Kandanga (playing with a last minute injury fill in from Witta) were victorious on the day 7 sets to 5.

The format for the day was four sets of mixed doubles per person. Sets were first to 6, however the format of short deuce and a sudden death tiebreak to five points at 5 games all was well received by all players, adding to the contest on the day.

There are only three more rounds to be played in this competition before a gala final's day where all teams will be invited to play regardless of their position on the ladder.

Pattemore House to Open Fridays!




In response to interest, the Friends of Patternore House are going to open 'Fairview" (Pattemore

Cooke Park

Cooke Park is right in the heart of Maleny.

In season, a glorious flame tree nods its welcome over paths next to a plaque on the front gates that reveals the park's history.

The plaque reads: This park was dedicated by all the children of the late A.C.K. & A.M. Cooke as a tribute to the memory of their parents.

Pioneer and dairy farmer Alfred Charles King Cooke, his wife Ada Margaret and children settled in Maleny in the early 1900's and the family played a primary role in the town's development.

Granddaughter Margaret
Thompson (nee Cooke), resident of
Witta, is proud of her family

history. "In 1909, Granddad built a house in Maple Street for his family and named it 'Rosedale'. Later, it was converted to a guest house and is now known as Maleny Lodge.

He owned that land where Cooke Park is now situated and also the block next to it which he donated to the community for an ambulance station.

He also built the cattle saleyards which were next to the pub (where Woolworth is today) and then started a stock auction business," said Margaret.

Ada Cooke died 13 years before her husband and after A.C.K Cooke died in 1946, the family donated a block of land in Maple Street to the community. A park was created in honour of their parents.

In 2009, Sunshine Coast Council implemented a streetscape upgrade in Maleny. This included work on the Cooke Park frontage adding to the charm of the playground with its cubby house, swings, climbing chains and spinner.

This equipment was again recently upgraded by the Council.

So as you pass by Cooke Park, or wait for the bus out front, spare a thought for those pioneers like A.C.K. Cooke and his family, whose generosity in making land available to our community helped provide families of today somewhere cool to sit or play with their children.

Rotary Launches Battery Recycling Project


As a contributor to recycling programs, Rotary Maleny is proud to offer a place where small used batteries may be deposited.

Some of you may know that last year, Queensland's Governor His Excellency the Honourable Paul de Jersey and Mrs de Jersey were invited to visit the

Pioneer Village to thank the volunteers, donors and supporters of Glenferna. For many years, the property was known as "Glenfairie" Glenferna, a once-grand house near the Montville turn off, is a building that links us to the past. In the early days of the 20th Century, Maleny did not have a large enough population to warrant a post office, so Glenferna was registered as a Receiving Office

The Maleny Historical Society have just received an acceptance letter from Government House letting them know that their invitation has been accepted and the date of their visit will be Saturday 15 June 2019.

This is exciting news for all the many people who



have been involved in this removal and restoration project; we look forward to hearing more details as the time gets closer.


What is Parkrun Australia?
