# **Building Better Regions**

One of the successful roles MDSRC carries out is helping member clubs identify and prepare grant applications. An important new grant opportunity will shortly be available, with the Commonwealth Government about to announce Round 4 of its "Building Better Regions" funding

Grants can be up to a maximum of \$10 million, and MDSRC is currently evaluating opportunities for possible projects on the Maleny Community Precinct. However, this does not exclude consideration by all member clubs to either submit applications, or pursue a collaboration with MDSRC for projects.

Assistance is available for projects on the Precinct, or at other sites with facilities that require additional development or upgrading, such as facilities at the Showgrounds or Witta Rec Club.

The qualified JP is available to witness documents such as Wills, Power of Attorney, affidavits, land transfer documents and other legal documents.

The Maleny Neighbourhood Centre and the Maleny Library have worked together to ensure that the times Justice of the Peace services are offered in each place do not conflict.

This close association also means that either the Library or Maleny Neighbourhood Centre can redirect enquiries.



# Maleny Cheese Factory reopens

Nine months after an arsonist targeted their factory, Maleny Cheese has finally reopened to the public, in time for the school holidays.

Police are still seeking help to find the firebug who was filmed on security cameras flying through the air at the site of the explosion.

Owner Sara Bucher says it was 'heart breaking' seeing cars 'streaming in' and having to turn them away. Fortunately, production was able to restart four days after the attack.

We were determined not to let the very foolish actions have a mark on our business," Mrs Bucher said.

The cafe, overlooking the factory floor has been rebuilt.

More than 30 jobs have been created by the 15-yearold business which is supplied by four local dairies, including one they bought themselves.

Maleny Settlers Green Progress

If you are a regular on the Community Precinct, no doubt you will have seen some earthworks happening on 'Maleny Settlers Green' - the new park that is being built on Maleny Sports Park by MDSRC and Maleny's service clubs. The overarching theme of the new park is to celebrate of the role of the area's earliest female settlers. With permission granted by Sunshine Coast Council to MDSRC and the project team, the developmental works are now set to move along at a good pace, with the locations of internal grassy paths mapped out already.

A small grassed amphitheatre has been crafted where it is envisaged poetry readings and other uses can take place, and some of the permanent seating is expected to go in shortly in the shape of timber park benches.

Rotary Club of Maleny, one of the project partners, have volunteered to set the new benches into position, next to the the magnificent fig tree in the north of Maleny Settlers Green.

Once installed, walkers will be able to rest a while and take in the sweeping vistas, some of the best views on the Precinct, and one of the reasons the site was chosen.

The installation of play equipment is planned, along with plantings of trees, shrubs and garden beds for visitors to enjoy as they take the meandering path through Maleny Settlers Green.

Families will also have direct access onto to the 5th Light Horse Regiment's "Ziza Fields" where they can enjoy the additional open space for picnics and games together.

Maleny Settlers Green is located close by the new car-park and the Maleny Trail network, making it very accessible by all.






