Emergency Services information display





Dark Sky Park

Weather permitting, this coming Saturday 9th March is the next public star viewing session at Dark Sky Park on the Community Precinct.

South East Queensland (and Maleny) is very lucky indeed to have such an excellent new dark sky viewing site. The Brisbane Astronomical Society (BAS) teamed up with the Maleny Golf Club in creating the viewing venue. With support from Sunshine Coast Council, a study was undertaken to find the best viewing site on the Coast. Maleny Golf Club was the equal darkest site of the 13 that were reviewed.

The Golf Club has a generous number of retired scientists and



astronomers, who rarely play golf at night, and so are delighted to share their facility.

Unlike the other coast locations, the MGC comes complete with public toilets, facilities and a viewing deck, just 5 metres away from the telescopic site.

Combined with the recently approved Sunshine Coast Urban Lighting Master Plan, which will see all the Coast's 30,000 streetlights replaced with International Dark Sky Association approved lights over the next five years, it is an exciting time for Sunshine Coast, Maleny and Brisbane astronomers.

Maleny's blast from the past!

The photo below shows Charlie Lovegrove's 1919 left hand drive T Ford that drove around the roads of Maleny for many years. The Tin Lizzie as it was known is generally regarded as the first affordable automobile, the car that opened travel to the common middle-class person.

The car was bought new in 1919 when Mr Lovegrove was working in the USA. He returned to Australia in 1922 and took over the running of family farms at Uralba, Beaudesert & Maleny and used the Ford to travel between the farms.

Descendant relatives of the Lovegroves still live locally.

The vehicle was sold in the 1960's and is now in Lismore.

Imagine if it was your home. Just how would you cope, especially in the very short term when you have left home with asolutely nothing?




