# **Nearly Maleny Show Time Again**

The first Maleny Show was held in June in 1923. The following year, a pavilion had been built, using plans supplied by the Caboolture Show Society - and the show was held in April.

This first pavilion was extensively renovated and refurbished during 1987 by Maleny builders Ed Lawley & Co, for the 50th Annual Show. With thanks to Maleny Historical Society

This close association also means that either the Library or Maleny Neighbourhood Centre can redirect enquiries.



# Maleny Groups benefit from Community **Benefit Fund Grants**

Member for Glass House, Andrew Powell, is thrilled that Round 99 of the Gambling Community Benefit Fund (GCBF) has brought a number of grants to community groups within the Maleny area.

"This is the first round of grants to be rolled out this year, and what a stellar outcome we've had here in Glass House!"

The fund provides one-off grants to Queensland not-for-profit community organisations with revenue sourced from gaming taxes and distributes approximately \$53 million per year to Queensland communities.

"These grants provide money to community organisations who often struggle to raise enough funds to maintain or upgrade their premises through traditional fundraising. The grants also enable them to provide further resources or expand their services to the community."

Recipients of grants to Maleny community organisations include:

- ☆ Blackall Range Woodcrafters Guild Inc. - \$4,475 to purchase an air dryer and saw
- ☆ Maleny and District Horse & Pony Club - \$10,000 to construct an equestrian round yard
- ☆ Maleny Film Society Inc. \$800 to print festival flyers
- ☆ Maleny Neighbourhood Centre Association Inc. - \$9,939 to purchase equipment and upgrade website
- Montville Tennis Club Inc. \$35,000 to resurface courts and upgrade nets
- The Maleny Gym Inc. \$8,250 to put towards design, construction and scheduling plans

Organisations are encouraged to apply for funding in the next round as rounds become due.

# Maleny's Dark Sky Park

Don't forget the Sunshine Coast Dark Sky Astronomers are keen to share their knowledge of the night skies with you right here in Maleny each month.

They are a group of astronomers seeking to preserve the night sky from light polution and share the wonders of the stars with the Maleny community.

They hold regular public star gazing evenings at their Maleny home, the Maleny Golf Club and ask when you turn up (on dusk) that you dim your lights for the comfort of all as you arrive to park, wear warm clothing and make a small donation on the night.

In exchange you can expect a laser pointer education to explain what is going on, prior to being able to experience the stars by looking at them through their enormous telescopes, each set to view wonderful stars in close up. Or bring your own - they are always ready with advice and pointers!

# Maleny Bowls Club



Coaching for beginners and others is available on the lawn from 8 am to 10 am on Saturdays. are popular sessions in a friendly, relaxed atmosphere.




With the advent of cooler months playing times revert to the earlier start of 1 pm for games to begin at 1.30 pm.


Did you know that Lewis Carroll featured
