This close association also means that either the Library or Maleny Neighbourhood Centre can re-direct enquiries.

Friends and family gathered to again remember the beautiful soul who was suddenly taken from us on the 28th of January 2018.

Maleny Pony Club, with the assistance of the Maleny Equestrian Group (MEGS) have been working together over the past 17 months to find a fitting and permanent tribute for Serena.

The idea of a round yard was conceived to enable users to work with their horses in a smaller

safe environment than the arena. With the blessings of Serena's family, the project was undertaken and now sits in a place where Serena spent so much of her time working with her beloved horses, at the Maleny Show Grounds, as a permanent memorial.

# Who Remembers this?

## "The Old School Bus + Maleny Schools"

The first school on the range was the Blackall Range Provisional School. It was housed in one of Mr. McCarthy's sheds. William Verrant was the first teacher and he enrolled twelve pupils. In 1937 it became known as the Wootha State School and closed in 1949 after operating for 63 years.

Whilst the Witta School opened in 1892 and was closed in 1974, the Maleny North State School was opened in 1896 and first closed in 1914, but was re-opened in 1922 and continued to operate until 1953.

The Bald Know State School opened in 1902 and continued until 1945. In 1903 the Maleny Central State School opened in Cedar Street, Maleny. In the same year the Curramore State School opened and closed in 1939.

Booroobin State School opened in 1919 and was closed in 1953.

Maleny High School opened on the new site at the top of Bunya Street in 1987.

### Maleny School Buses

Once upon a time to get to school students rode their bikes, horses and even walked, but today air-conditioned modern school buses are the "way to go".

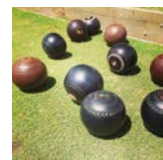

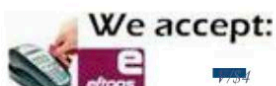
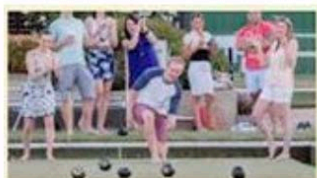

Play days on the picturesque lawns at the bottom of the show-ground are 1.00 pm for 1.30 pm on Thursdays and Sundays.

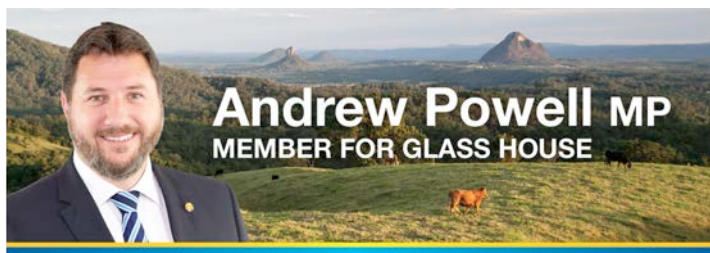

## Be safe around wood burners in the home

A Sunshine Coast resident had a lucky escape this week when wood stored too close to a combustion heater ignited.

Luckily damage was contained to the immediate wall and ceiling and minimal smoke damage was caused throughout the house.



With the present period of colder weather upon us wood fires are being put to good use, however extra care needs to be taken to ensure that they are safe.

It is important that the clearance is adequate between the wood burner and combustible materials such as ceilings, walls, floors, furniture and indeed the wood pile that is awaiting to be burnt within the firebox.

Another common cause of chimney fires is creosote inside the chimney catching fire and burning inside the chimney, thus it is important to regularly clean the chimney.

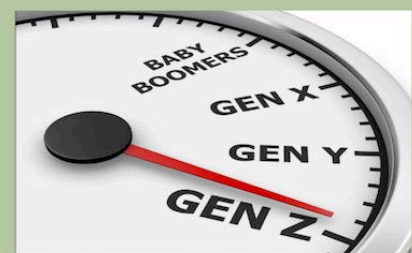
