

The qualified JP is available to witness documents such as Wills, Power of Attorney, affidavits, land transfer documents and other legal documents.

The Maleny Neighbourhood Centre and the Maleny Library have worked together to ensure that the times Justice of the Peace services are offered in each place do not conflict.

This close association also means that either the Library or Maleny Neighbourhood Centre can redirect enquiries.







Stronger Communities Programme

The Government has allocated \$150,000 to our electorate of Fisher for this financial year to make small scale grants for community groups under the Stronger Communities Programme. Grants between \$2,500 and \$20,000 will be available for community groups to upgrade their facilities or buy new equipment.

In previous rounds of this Programme in Fisher we have won grants for many projects including new bathroom facilities for C&K Kindy in Mooloolaba, new lathes and an extension for Caloundra Woodworking Club, an underground water system for Beerwah Sports-ground, and an Archive room for Peachester Historical Society.

If your community group is interested in applying for funding under this grant the first stage is to make an Expression of Interest to Andrew Wallace's office.

Dogs on-leash at the Maleny Community Precinct

Please ensure that your dogs are kept on leash at all times when using the Maleny Community Precinct

Complaints received by Council have resulted in Local Laws Officers patrolling the area.

Several owners have been fined recently; being found with a dog off-leash on the Precinct will cost a \$243 fine per dog.



Whilst the majority of owners do the right thing, unfortunately there are some who disregard the well signed information.

The best way to go is to respect the rights and safety of all Precinct users and make sure your fur babies are on the leash at all times. This is particularly important on the Unity Water Treatment Plant area, that is not yet officially opened to the public.

Restored wetlands there provide a precious plant, animal and bird-nesting environment for us all to enjoy, and these are at risk from off-leash dogs, particularly eggs and chicks in wetlands nests.

Please be mindful of others and the environment, respect the local law and avoid penalties.


For an outlay of \$15 you are assured of a great day, with play starting at 11.30am sharp and usually finishing around 4 o'clock.


