and teamwork by taking part in sailing, kayaking, power boating, bushwalking, rifle shootin , drum band, parade activities, organised camps with other units and many other activities.

There are some 82 Units across the country with between 20 and 80 cadets and Maleny can be rightly proud of the young men and women who represent us at so many official and other futions throughout the year.

But it is time for both Eddie and Linda to retire, and they are to resign

from the Australian Navy Cadets to spend some of their twilight years with more time to themselves!

They will not be continuing beyond the end of 2019, and need to find replacement Staff quic ly to enable training and handover to occur as seamlessly as possible.

They seek interested personnel in the community who are willing and able to take over the reins and to that end will be able to offer support as Unit Support Committee Members in areas

where assistance is needed.

There is no requirement for a Defence background, and following is



a brief outline of the requirement and commitment:

- Must be an Australian Citizen
- Will need a Blue Card and Police Check
- Defence Background advantageous
- Skills in Sailing, Kayaking, Training and Bushwalking would help.
- Cadets Parade every Wednesday evening from 1730 to 2100, except during School Holidays
- There will be some weekend activities and at least one 7 day camp per year
- Must want to work with both boys and girls between 12 and 18 to provide training with a maritime emphasis
- There is a small Cadet Force Allowance paid to ANC Staff members

This would be a sad day given the amount of support the Cadets have provided to the community since 1996. It would also mean that the Unit Building on the Showgrounds would revert to Sunshine Coast Council ownership under our current tenancy agreement and the youth of Maleny and surrounds would be denied a valuable environment to grow up in.





Talking LAW – with Lember and Williams Interesting Court Applications

We caught up with Maleny lawyer Carolyn Williams, who relayed an interesting example of what can happen when your Will is not properly made.

In December 2018, the defacto partner of the deceased applied to the Brisbane Supreme Court for an order that a video recording her deceased partner had made (and retained as a file on his personal omputer) be declared his valid Will.

The deceased was to purchase a new motorcycle, and on that morning his partner asked him to make a video to record his testamentary intentions. Very unluckily, later that day he was involved in an accident, sustaining significa t injuries that resulted in his death.

He recorded his wishes that "everything goes to" his defacto, with further money set aside for his daughter's education, and stated he would "fill out the damn orms later". He also made clear that his estranged wife was not to receive anything from his estate.

His estranged wife opposed the application, alleging the video was not

intended to be the deceased's Will.

However, the Court found that the deceased did intend the video to operate as a Will, and accepted that he had testamentary capacity at the time of making the video recording.

The video was consequently declared to form the Will of the deceased.



The Court Application was stressful, very costly and time-consuming for all of the parties involved, highlighting that it's far more certain and cost effective to organise your affairs y preparing a properly written Will addressing disposition of your assets in a timely manner.



Justice of the Peace services are offered at the Maleny Neighbourhood Centre on Tuesdays between 9.30am and 12.30pm and on Thursdays between 12.30pm and 2.30pm, by a qualified Justice of the Peace.

The qualified JP is vailable to witness documents such as Wills, Power of Attorney, affi vits, land transfer documents and other legal documents.

The Maleny Neighbourhood Centre and the Maleny Library have worked together to ensure that the times Justice of the Peace services are offered in each place do not conflict.

This close association also means that either the Library or Maleny Neighbourhood Centre can re-direct enquiries.


