

This close association also means that either the Library or Maleny Neighbourhood Centre can redirect enquiries.



Unusual applications - informal testamentary documents

In a Western Australia case decided last August, the deceased's second wife and the deceased's daughter from his first marriage sought to prove, as an 'informal Will', a video found on the deceased laptop, following his death.

The quality of the video was very poor. An expert technician was engaged but he could not resolve that quality issue. The audio and video did not synchronise and the audio was not complete; even cut off in parts. The recordings were made approximately 5 years before the deceased passed away. In those circumstances, the Court was *not* satisfied that the deceased had intended that the video recording was intended to be a

Will, and declaration of testamentary intention.

Because the video was incomplete, the content was not comprehensive, and the deceased had never mentioned the video to any other family member prior to his death.



On that basis the Court would not accept the video was a complete expression of the deceased's testamentary intentions – and ruled that it could not be considered a valid Will.

The Court Application had been stressful, costly and time-consuming for all of the parties involved, highlighting that it's far more certain and cost effective to organise your affairs by preparing a properly written Will addressing disposition of your assets in a timely manner.


