The qualified JP is available to witness documents such as Wills, Power of Attorney, affidavits, land transfer documents and other legal documents.

The Maleny Neighbourhood Centre and the Maleny Library have worked together to ensure that the times Justice of the Peace services are offered in each place do not conflict.

This close association also means that either the Library or Maleny Neighbourhood Centre can redirect enquiries.



Remember when? Tytherleighs Store 1908

The attached photo is of John Tytherleigh's Maleny store, which was built in 1906 near the corner of what is now Teak and Maple Streets, in the area where in 2015 the ANZ Bank is located.

Tytherleigh is pictured in the white shirt with three unknown customers. He later moved his business further up Maple Street to the site where the present day Maleny Super IGA store is located and in 1912 built a Manager's residence next door. Today this residence is Bunya House, Maleny Credit Union.

The Maleny Universal Providers store was Mr Tytherleigh's third, having started a business in Landsborough in 1893 and then

opening a branch store in Woombye in 1899 and later a store in Caloundra. John Tytherleigh's Maleny store had the phone number 2.


He also owned a dairy farm at the end of Bridge Creek Road Maleny, which was run by share farmers and known as the Tytherleigh Estate or Frogs' Hollow.


