Lest We Forget

ANZAC Day is a national day of remembrance in Australia and New Zealand that broadly commemorates all Australians and New Zealanders "who served and died in all wars, conflicts, and peacekeeping operations" and "the contribution and suffering of all those who have served".

It is observed on 25 April each year, Anzac Day and was originally devised to honour the members of the Australian and New Zealand Army Corps (ANZAC) who served in the Gallipoli Campaign, their first engagement in the Great War (1914–1918). April 25 was officially named Anzac Day in 1916.

Anzac Day marks the anniversary of the first campaign that led to major casualties for Australian and New Zealand forces during the First World War.

A dawn service was held on the Western Front by an Australian battalion on the first anniversary of the Gallipoli landing on April 25, 1916. The timing of the dawn service is based on the time that the ANZAC forces started the landing on the Gallipoli peninsula.

In Queensland gambling is forbidden outside of licensed venues; however, due to the significance of this tradition, twoup is legal only on Anzac Day as this was an extremely popular pastime with ANZAC soldiers.

Anzac Day now promotes a sense of unity, perhaps more effectively than any other day on the national calendar.



J.P. Services in Maleny

Justice of the Peace services are offered at the Maleny Neighbourhood Centre on Tuesdays between 9.30am and 12.30pm and on Thursdays between 12.30 pm and 2.30 pm, by a qualified Justice of the Peace.

The qualified JP is available to witness documents such as Wills, Power of Attorney, affidavits, land transfer documents and other legal documents.

The Maleny Neighbourhood Centre and the Maleny Library have worked together to ensure that the times Justice of the Peace services are offered in each place do not conflict.

This close association also means that either the Library or Maleny Neighbourhood Centre can redirect enquiries.



Short Films tell the story at Pattemore House this Saturday

Without the 5 year effort made by Emily English

(nee Pattemore) it was entirely possible that "Fairview" (Pattemore House) would not have been preserved for all time and to share with visitors today. That's how long the paperwork took Emily to ensure that

the farmhouse was entered onto the Qld State Heritage Register:

Her father Ernest Pattemore was one of the four brothers who built Fairview in 1907. The Friends

of Pattemore House vice President, Don English, is the subject of a delightful short film "Saving Fairview" that tells the story in his words of his mother's journey to achieve the listing, and his memories of Fairview.

Demonstrating how the passion of one person can make a real difference in preserving our heritage, it is one of 2 films especially commissioned by the Friends to provide an engaging record of the history of Fairview and the early days of Maleny.

The second short film, as told



by Pattemore descendant Val Carbery, whose grandfather Bill Pattemore also helped build Fairview, tells the tale of family outings to Fairview with her parents in the 1940's. It includes memories of her grandfather JR Pattemore, who lived at Fairview until he died in 1947, and Val's mother Alma who lived away from her family as a child, sent to care for her grandparents at Fairview from about 1915 until she married in 1934

Both the interviewees' grandfathers were Maleny pioneers who helped build Fairview, and both their mothers contributed in a unique way to the history of Maleny.

You can see both films this Saturday, when Pattemore House at 15, Porters Lane, Maleny is once again open to the public between 1p.m. and 4 pm Entry costs \$5.00 for adults and children are free. There is plenty of parking. Afternoon teas are available for purchase.

The Rees Brothers


The three Rees brothers, Garry, Noel and Lance who returned from the war are all remembered on the Maleny RSL WW11 Honour Roll.



The Rees family had their origins in Caerleon, Monmouthshire, Wales. Henry Oliver Rees emigrated to Australia in 1883 and established himself and a new family in Queensland.

He was an early selector of land, grew fruit and established a dairy farm just west of Maleny.. This area was to be given the name of Reesville.
