State's Cross Country Championships on Sunday

Queensland Athletics extends an invitation to all distance runners to participate in the 2019 Queensland Cross Country Championships on Sunday 28th Juy. All runners aged 6 and up, of all abilities, are encouraged to compete. There are no qualifying standards - everyone is welcome.

The competition is also the final selection trial for the State Cross Country Team (U14-Open & Multiclass).

STATE CHAMPIONSHIP MEDALS

Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to the first three individual place-getters in each age group. There will also be a team's championship in each age group as stated above with medals being awarded to the first three QA club teams to finish.

Individual Age Groups

Under 7, Under 8, Under 9, Under 10, Under 11, Under 12, Under 13, Under 14, Under 15, Under 16, Under 17, Under 18, Under 20, Open, Masters 35-44, Masters 45-54, Masters 55-64, Masters 65+.



Multi-class athletes will compete together in the 2000m/3000m race, with medals awarded for 10-12 years, U14/U16/U18/U20.

Age is calculated as at 31 December 2019. Masters age calculated as at 28 July 2019.

Team Age Groups

Three runners from the same QA club, in the same age group, constitute a team. Athletes are automatically placed in teams according to their club and their finishing order.

U8, U10, U11, U12, U14, U16, U18, U20, Open, Masters 35-54, Masters 55+, Multi-class 10-12 and Multi-class 13-19.

First race is at 11.50 am with the last race at 3.30 pm.

Dogs on Leash at the Maleny Wetlands

(Unity Water Treatment Area)

Please ensure that your dogs are kept on leash at all times. Local Laws Officers will be patrolling the Unity Water Wetlands area Porter's Farm, North Maleny and having a dog off-leash in this area will result in a \$243 fine per dog.

While a majority of owners do the right thing by keeping their dog on a lead, unfortunately there are some who do not, and as a result Council has received numerous complaints, and recently a request to have the Unity Water area declared a 'no dog zone'.

Dogs off-leash in the wetlands can result in valuable habitat, egg and animal destruction.

A reminder that the entire Maleny Community Precinct is a dog on-leash area; please be mindful of others and respect the local law - and always take your doggy poop home.



Coaching for beginners and others is available on the lawn from 8 am to 10 am on Saturdays. These are popular sessions in a friendly, relaxed atmosphere.




