Update: it's been a difficult transition to Brisbane for Ryan, who's struggled with being more sensitive to noise and clatter of hospital surroundings

after all his brain has been through with the meningitis. It can be caused by bacteria or viruses and is a very serious disease.

As of last week however, he is settling into his new routine, which involves many different therapists. He's concentrating working with Occupational Therapists and learning just to stand again.

Ryan had a difficult two days over the last weekend, with a 2 hr MRI where he had to lie very still in a confined space, and then the prospect of brain and hip surgery due to the infections still ongoing in those areas.

Thankfully, his team of specialists have decided that his clinical observations are good and that more time is needed to allow his body to heal itself before resorting to surgery.

The qualified JP is available to witness documents such as Wills, Power of Attorney, affidavits, land transfer documents and other legal documents.

This close association also means that either the Library or Maleny Neighbourhood Centre can redirect enquiries.

- O Fodder (mixed chaff) Stan and Gilbert Patternore
- O Heaviest potatoes Gilbert Pattemore






