Local contractors have been hard at work at the MDSRC Clubhouse, and if you are a regular walker on the Precinct, you may have seen the slab that's been poured already.

This is the start of a storage extension for the building (with grateful thanks to the weather gods!). Maleny's 5th Light Horse Regiment were successful in obtaining funding from the Qld Government's Community Benefit Fund for these works, along with funds for the installation of a ceiling projector and drop-down screen in the clubhouse.

The storage extension will free up more space in the building, with the screen and projector also giving user groups more flexibility for their presentations.

Maleny contractors have been engaged for the works and MDSRC plans that all will be completed by the end of June.

Justice of the Peace services are offered at the Maleny Neighbourhood Centre on Tuesdays between 9.30am and 12.30pm and on Thursdays between 12.30 pm and 2.30 pm, by a qualified Justice of the Peace.

The qualified JP is available to witness documents such as Wills, Power of Attorney, affidavits, land transfer documents and other legal documents.

The Maleny Neighbourhood Centre and the Maleny Library have worked together to ensure that the times Justice of the Peace services are offered in each place do not conflict.

This close association also means that either the Library or Maleny Neighbourhood Centre can redirect enquiries.






