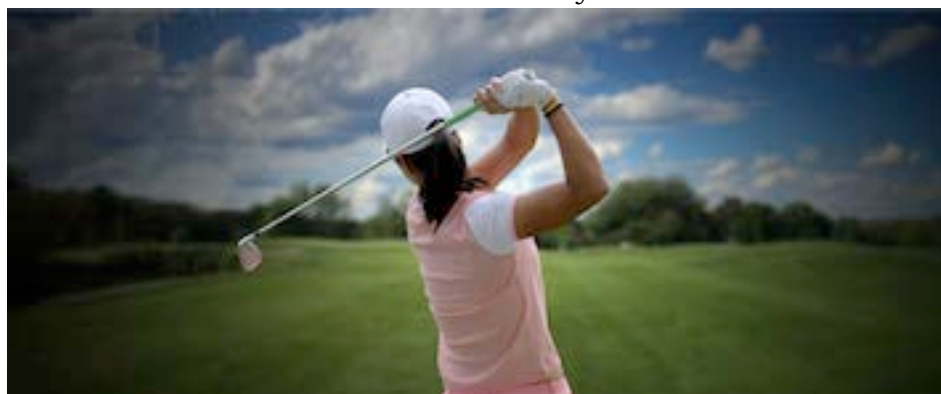

- complete the form then print, sign and return to the AEC.

Voting is compulsory in Australia; so make your vote count even if you are not here on election day.
