The qualified JP is available to witness documents such as Wills, Power of Attorney, affidavits, land transfer documents and other legal documents.

The Maleny Neighbourhood Centre and the Maleny Library have worked together to ensure that the times Justice of the Peace services are offered in each place do not conflict.

This close association also means that either the Library or Maleny Neighbourhood Centre can redirect enquiries.



The Governor of Old the Honourable Paul de Jersey was visibly impressed at the great turn out last Saturday, when he arrived to officially open 'Glenferna' at the Maleny Pioneer Village. On a perfect sunny and warm winter's day, locals, dignitaries, the families of Glenferna, the volunteers who made it all happen and many more enjoyed this memorable event.



The Maleny Historical Society made sure that all of their buildings and facilities were open, allowing all to stroll through exploring the village that also provides a home for the Maleny Mens Shed, the

Pioneer Ukuleles and the Blackall Range Horseless Carriage Club.

Delicious sandwiches, cakes and slices flowed, with much jolliness in the air as old friends and families reunited over morning tea. But the highlight of the day was the official opening

ceremony, with Chris Brooker M.C. leading the

excellent speakers through their paces. Uncle Noel of the Jinibara people gave a particularly inspiring speech that resonated with the appreciative crowd.

The Honourable Paul de Jersey spoke of the value of the preservation of Maleny's heritage in such a



unique project, personally thanking and then awarding the many volunteers who made it all possible over the last three years - and making clear his enjoyment at being back in Maleny.

As manager of the lengthy restoration project, Mrs Desley Malone was rightly singled out for special mention, as was her impressive restoration team, led by local builder Ed Lawley. Leone and Brian McFarlane (pictured) donated Glenferna to the Pioneer Village and also organised the marble and rock plaque at the front of the house.

The Sunshine Coast Council made sure there was seating and shade for all, and contributed the lovely cake that was shared by all at the conclusion of this special day.

"Glenferna" officially opened at Maleny Pioneer Village

Historical Maleny residence, Glenferna was shifted to the Maleny Historical Village on the 25th May 2016. This was just the start of a transformation by volunteers from the Maleny Historical Society to retain a part of Maleny's history.

On the 15th June,
2019 His Excellency
the Honourable
Paul de Jersey AC,
Governor of
Queensland officially
opened the building as
the latest addition to the
Maleny PioneerVillage.

Glenferna was built as a farmhouse at 1010 Maleny/
Landsborough Rd, Balmoral, by Edward Thynne in 1903. The land (790 acres) was originally selected by Isaac Burgess, subdivided, and in 1902 one portion was sold to the Thynne sisters, MM, JMP & EG Thynne (320 acres) and the other portion to their sibling, Edward T

F Thynne (469 acres). Edward Thynne called his house Glenferna, named from where their father, Andrew Joseph Thynne, originated from in Ireland. Glenferna was registered as a Receiving Office for mail in January 1904 and became known as Thynnes RO in 1906.

The School Museum will include memorabilia from the small schools that closed down within the

As Glenferna had in a previous life been the receiving point for the district mail service M.S. 373 Maleny. This service commenced in c1890 - this building will be partly used to tell the story of the early district schools as well as telecommunication to the district.

district - Blackall Range (Wootha), Witta, North Maleny, Bald Knob, Curramore, Booroobin, as well as

the Maleny State School, Maleny High School and the Ananda Marga River School.

Glenferna is one of the last remaining original buildings in the Maleny District. It provides a unique look back into the past and under what conditions our ancestors lived - a far cry from those conditions that we are able to avail ourselves of today!



Maleny's Junior Champ Needs Your Help

Two months after his 13th birthday Ryan Engle is seriously ill. From running around a football field on the Tuesday to being in ICU in an induced coma by the Saturday with meningitis.

Ryan has represented his state in the Queensland Track and Field team for the last three years, and broken Australian records every year.

He captained last year's 150strong Queensland team.

In 2017 he participated in the School Pacific Games in Adelaide and broke three games records. He also represented the State of Queensland for swimming.

He is also a talented rugby union player for the Sunshine Coastbased Maleny Bushrangers and in 2018 was Maleny's Junior Sportsperson of the Year.

He and his family need a lot of support to cope with the medical expenses such a situation involves and a Go Fund Me campaign has already seen friends, family and Maleny community clubs making donations to help out. the support they have received. 



The Gondoliers sparkles with Singers' verve

Gilbert and Sullivan's The Gondoliers has always been one of the duo's most popular comic operettas from its first production in 1889 when it became one of the longest running pieces of musical theatre ever, to the myriad professional, amateur and school productions of today.

Margaret Taylor's Maleny Singers production in the Community Centre does not disappoint. It bursts on the stage with energy, colour and the spirited singing of the women as they move about greeting each other in a Venetian piazza waiting eagerly for the arrival of the gondoliers, especially their heroes Giuseppe and Marco (Christopher Ward and Colin Dunn) who might just choose two of them as their brides.

Under Mrs Taylor's baton the company is supported by a 20piece orchestra (leader Chrissy Davis) that never intrudes and provides some of the special experiences of the show.

One of the most important aspects of any G&S operetta is the complicated plot and the absolute necessity of being able to understand Gilbert's iconic wit and satire. In this production the audience could hear almost every word, especially so with Ian Maleny Arts Council McMaster's Don Alhambra explaining the background twists and turns in his opening number 'Of that there is no shadow of doubt...'

Highlights of the production were the energy of the chorus, each one of whom entered into the spirit of the action; the quality voices of the three women, Sarah Jane Abbott (Casilda), Evalee Sharples, playing Gianetta, and Viera Keogh singing a spirited Tessa; the delicate quartet In a contemplative fashion; charming dances, and popular tenor Colin Dunn with what is arguably one of the best known of Sullivan's arias Take a pair of sparkling eyes.
